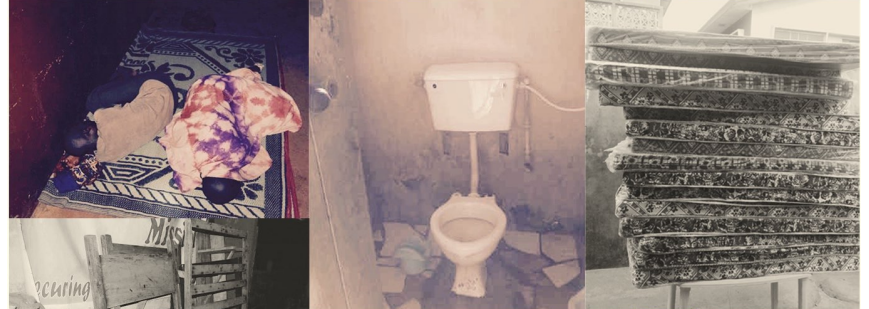

East Harlem Fellowship was able to make a generous contribution to the Goodwill Homeless Mission in Newark, NJ which will provide over 10,000 meals to the needy this year.

Breadbasket Feeding Program

Thanks to a generous gift from ministry friends, EHF was able to purchase a van that has enabled us to reach the community of East Harlem in a greater capacity. From May to October we were able to feed a total of 691 people, 217 families and 320 children.

Sparrows Women's Shelter Outreaches

East Harlem Fellowship has sponsored 3 prodigal banquets for single moms and children within a domestic violence shelter where we engage the women and children with the love of God.

Refuge Christian Club
